A folding chair's lightweight frame, availability of different styles and ability to fold and unfold for efficient set up and storage makes it the obvious choice for special events or large gatherings of people. Here's a simple guide to choosing folding chairs that best meet your needs.

School Outfitters Tips



Ventilated seat backs help keep users cool and comfortable over extended periods of time. Consider folding chairs with ventilated backs for outdoor events or spaces without AC.



For an event that requires ample workspace, pair your folding chairs with durable **folding tables** for a setup that's as functional as it is easy.



Tablet arm folding chairs offer even more versatility by providing a space for books and devices. Consider chairs with tablet arms for lecture halls or conference rooms.



Look for chairs with double hinges – these are small metal bars that help your chair unfold and stay in place. Two hinges on each side equal better durability.

Folding Chair Types



Steel Folding Chairs

Steel folding chairs are super durable and more affordable than upholstered folding chairs. Be sure to consider the gauge, or the thickness, of the steel frame – the lower the gauge, the stronger the steel and usually the higher the price of the chair. Most commercial folding chairs are constructed with 18- to-20-gauge steel. It is more affordable in the long run to invest in stronger folding chairs than it is to replace weaker folding chairs every few years.

Upholstered Folding Chairs

Folding chairs are available in fabric or vinyl upholstery. Fabric upholstery is the most formal looking seat material. Many people prefer fabric upholstery because it is softer than vinyl and causes less "sweating". However, vinyl upholstery is typically less expensive and quite a bit easier to keep clean. As such, fabric upholstered chairs are often found in formal event spaces like conference rooms or lecture halls, while vinyl upholstered chairs are used in dining spaces like banquet rooms or cafeterias.

Plastic Folding Chairs

Plastic folding chairs are a great option for outdoor events. Plastic chairs weigh less than steel chairs and therefore are a bit easier to fold and stack. Plus, they're a cinch to wipe clean and available in a variety of colors. Pro tip: Look for an inverted cross brace on the back legs. This brace is designed to keep your folding chair from sinking into the grass or mud. Cross braces are the metal bars that connect the front or back legs to each other.

Nesting Chairs

Nesting chairs have seats that flip up – this allows the chairs to "nest together" horizontally for efficient storage. Unlike traditional folding chairs, the legs on a nesting chair do not fold and unfold. Plus, they're typically equipped with casters. Nesting chairs are a great option for fast-paced learning environments that demand flexibility.
